

## All students, faculty and staff should:

Follow **CDC Universal Guidelines** of sanitizing and social distancing.

- Wash your hands and sanitize frequently and maintain social distancing at a minimum of 6 feet.
- Understand and be aware of proper use of cloth face coverings as outlined by the CDC.

## Our Studios & Facilities:

Will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized each evening after all classes & activities.

## Effective June 1, 2020 all students attending classes (or rehearsals) at SNHDT will adhere to the following Health and Safety Protocols:

- All students entering the building must provide SNHDT with a signed Hold Harmless Indemnity form.
- We will be following a “drop off and pick up only” policy as our offices, waiting area and lobby will remain CLOSED.
- **Students should remain outside, preferably in their car, until their scheduled class or activity time. An SNHDT Staff Member will come outside to inform students when it is their time to enter the building.**
- Dance rooms (or studio) will operate at a capacity at 50% of the maximum licensed occupancy or as social distancing allows, whichever is less.
- Only students and staff will be allowed in the building.
- Doors will remain open to increase airflow until class begins.
- Upon arrival, students will be asked to use hand sanitizer stations and must go directly to the dance room.
- All scheduled activities (class or rehearsal) will be modified to allow ample time between class and or rehearsals to allow for safe class transition and cleaning protocols.
- All hard surfaces, and student accessed spaces will be cleaned and disinfected at regular intervals based upon usage
- Students will need to wear proper dance attire and bring the shoes needed for each class.
- All attire should be “wear-in / wear out”. Bathrooms will not be used for changing. Limited use of bathrooms only.
- Personal items are at the discretion of the student’s family.
- Dancers must leave the building and re-enter if they are scheduled for multiple classes or activities. No one will be allowed to “hang out” inside the building when not in class.
- The studio floors have been marked for social distancing. Dancers will be asked to remain within their own area during class. An “X” will be placed in the center of each square to provide further guidance.
- If the dance barre is used, dancers will be spaced 6 to 8 feet apart and the barre will be sanitized after use.
- Exercise mats will not be used or made available.
- You may bring personal water bottles into the studio however they must be removed or otherwise disposed of after use.
- No snacks or other food items will be allowed in the studio.
- Staff will wear cloth face masks or coverings during hours of operation when social distancing cannot occur or when they are not participating in strenuous activity.
- We will not have a “lost and found” and any attire, shoes, water bottles or personal items will be disposed of at the end of the day. Please take all personal belonging with you.
- Students who do not comply with studio regulations after one warning will be asked to leave the facility.
- Students who have repeat offenses will not be allowed to return to the studio until all Covid-19 restrictions have been lifted and all operations have returned to normal. Missed classes will not be made up and paid tuition will be forfeited.
- One parent, caregiver or guardian MUST accompany students ages 0-7 into the classroom. Face mask please!
- Students ages 8+ Drop off and pick-up only.
