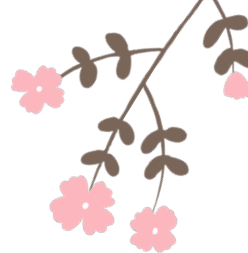
Princess Camp Tuition:
