Ages 6-8 and 9-12

This workshop is designed for both the beginner and intermediate-level dancer, ages 6–8 and 9–12. Our Young Dancer's Workshop is an introduction to more serious dance training. For students ages 6–8 no previous training is required. For older students ages 9–12 previous dance training is required. Students will receive a daily ballet class along with additional classes in jazz, modern/contemporary dance and/or stretch and dance conditioning.

WHAT TO WEAR?

Girls should wear a leotard (any color) and pink tights, pink ballet slippers and Jazz oxfords for Jazz (if you have them) bare feet for modern/contemporary. Girls should have their hair secured back in a bun or similar style.

Boys should wear dark-colored sweats (or shorts), a white T-shirt and ballet shoes or Jazz oxfords.

Please bring a light snack and drink (water is best) for break times.

Our studios will be open shortly after 9 AM. The first class begins at 9:30 AM. Children should be picked up at 12:15 PM.
