Dress Code

Pre-Dance, Pre-School, Pre-Ballet and Tap and Ballet

- **GIRLS:** pink leotard, pink tights & pink ballet shoes*
 - **BOYS:** White t-shirt, black tights or dark sweat pants or shorts & black ballet shoes*
- *Black tap shoes are needed for Pre-School 2 and Tap & Ballet classes. Hair should be neatly pulled back from the child's face for class. Jewelry, tutus and leg warmers are permitted in class at the discretion of the instructor so long as they are not a distraction.*

Ballet Classes

- **LEVELS 1-6:** Leotard: black, any style
- **LEVEL 7:** Leotard: any color, any style
- All levels: Pink tights and pink ballet shoes
- Hair should be worn in a bun or similar style. Short hair should be secured away from face.

Adult Ballet and Adult Tap

There are no restrictions on the dance apparel worn for adults in any dance class or in adult ballet or adult tap classes

Boy's Ballet

- Black tights, Dark Sweatpants or Jazz Pants
 - Plain, Solid-colored T-shirt
- White or black ballet slippers or black jazz oxfords

Modern-Contemporary

- Solid color leotard, Solid color footless, stirrup or capri tights (no tan or pink tights please)
- Solid color unitard may also be worn. Bare feet, No Shoes

Jazz/Contemporary & Hip Hop

- Leotard: solid color, any style. Tights: solid color, jazz pants may be worn
 - Jazz Oxfords or Jazz Sneakers. NO STREET SNEAKERS.
 - Hair pulled back in ponytail or similar style.

Tap

- Leotard: solid color, any style
- Tights: solid color, jazz pants may be worn
 - Tap: Black Tap shoes
